



1991 Elections

N.B - For the 1991 elections, the number of constituencies increased from 27 to 28.

On 29th December, 1990 the Governor General issued a proclamation dissolving Parliament and Writs appointing Monday 7th January, 1991 as Nomination Day and Tuesday 22nd January, 1991 as Election Day. The Supervisor of Elections was Dennis A. Smith and the Deputy Supervisor of Elections was Mersada Elcock.

One thousand seven hundred and nine (1,709) Election Officers were deployed at the Polling Stations as follows:

There were 191,000 registered electors, 89,354 males and 101, 646 females, of which 63.7% or 121,696 voted – 55, 160 males and 66, 536 females. The BLP received 42.5%, DLP 50.3%, NDP 6.8% and IND 0.4% of the votes cast.

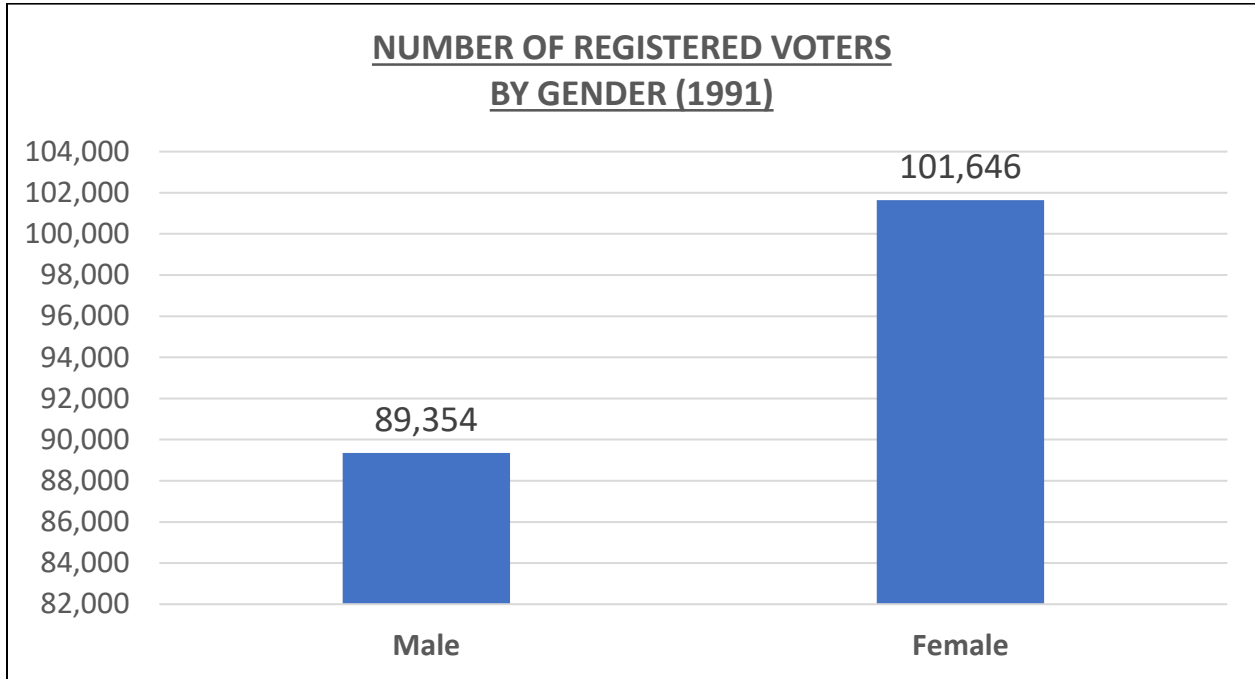


Figure 1: Number of registered voters by gender (1991)

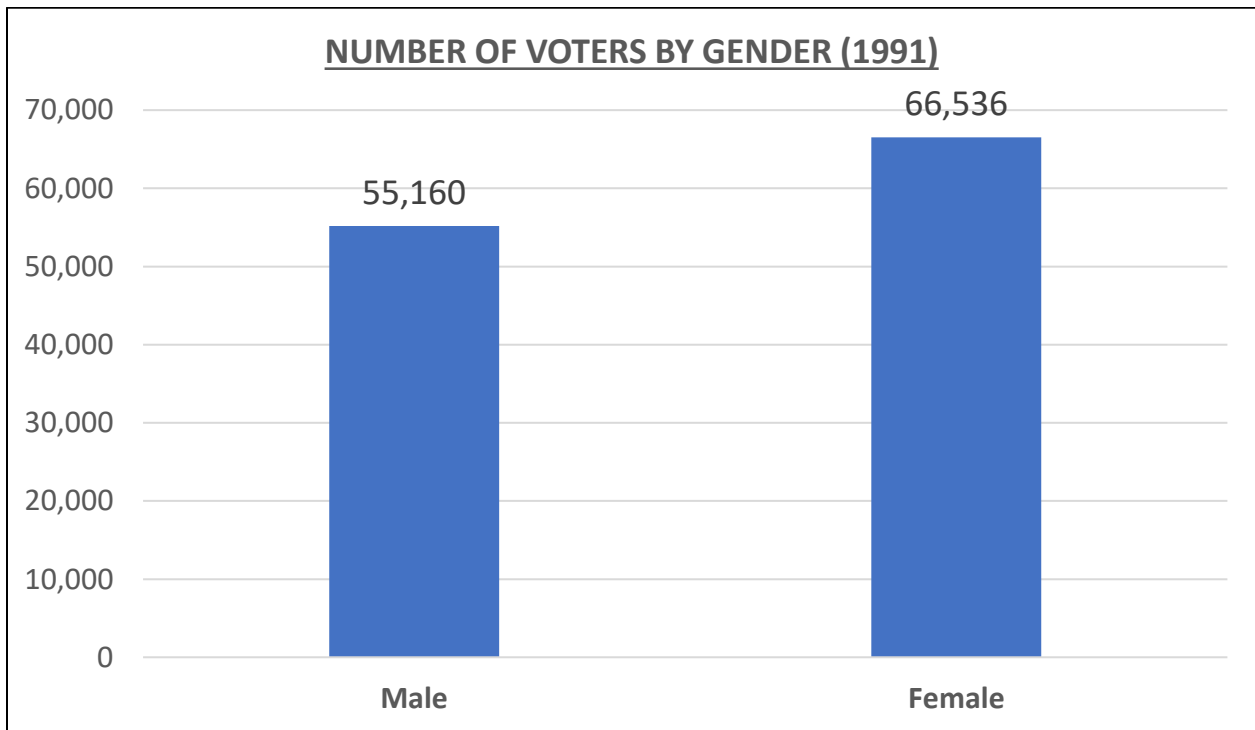


Figure 2: Number of voters by gender (1991)

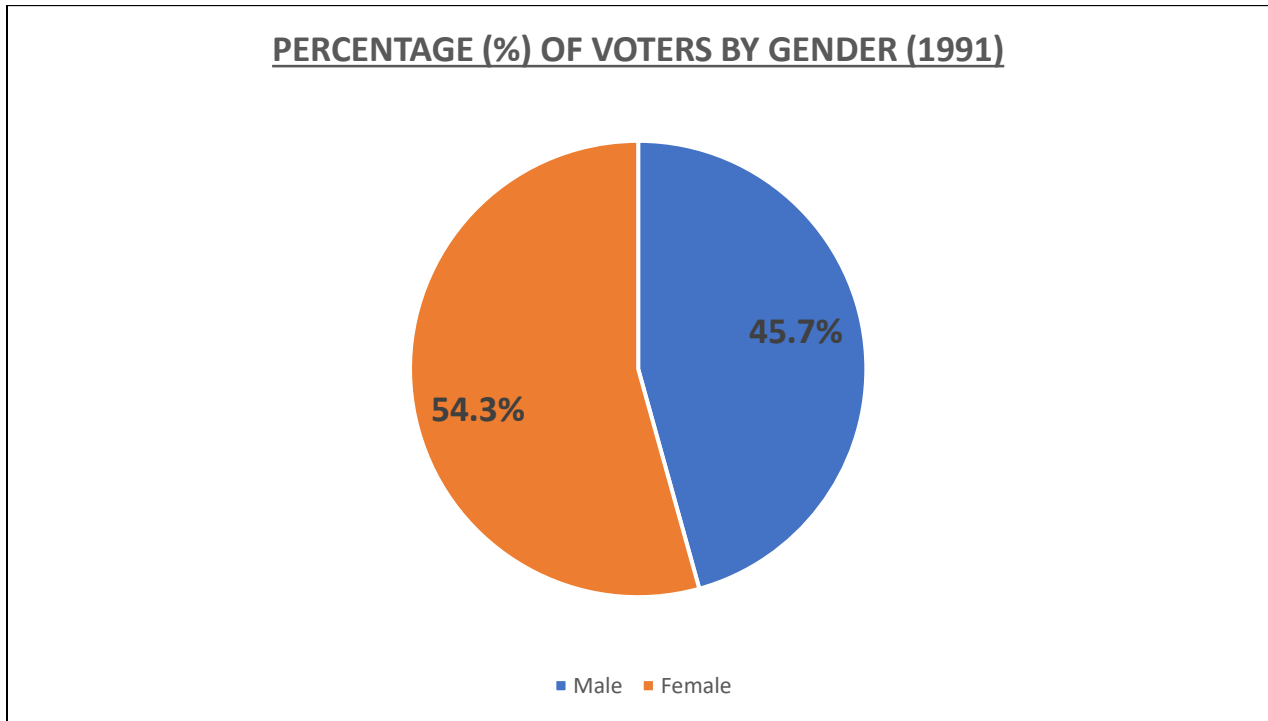


Figure 3: Percentage of voters by gender (1991)

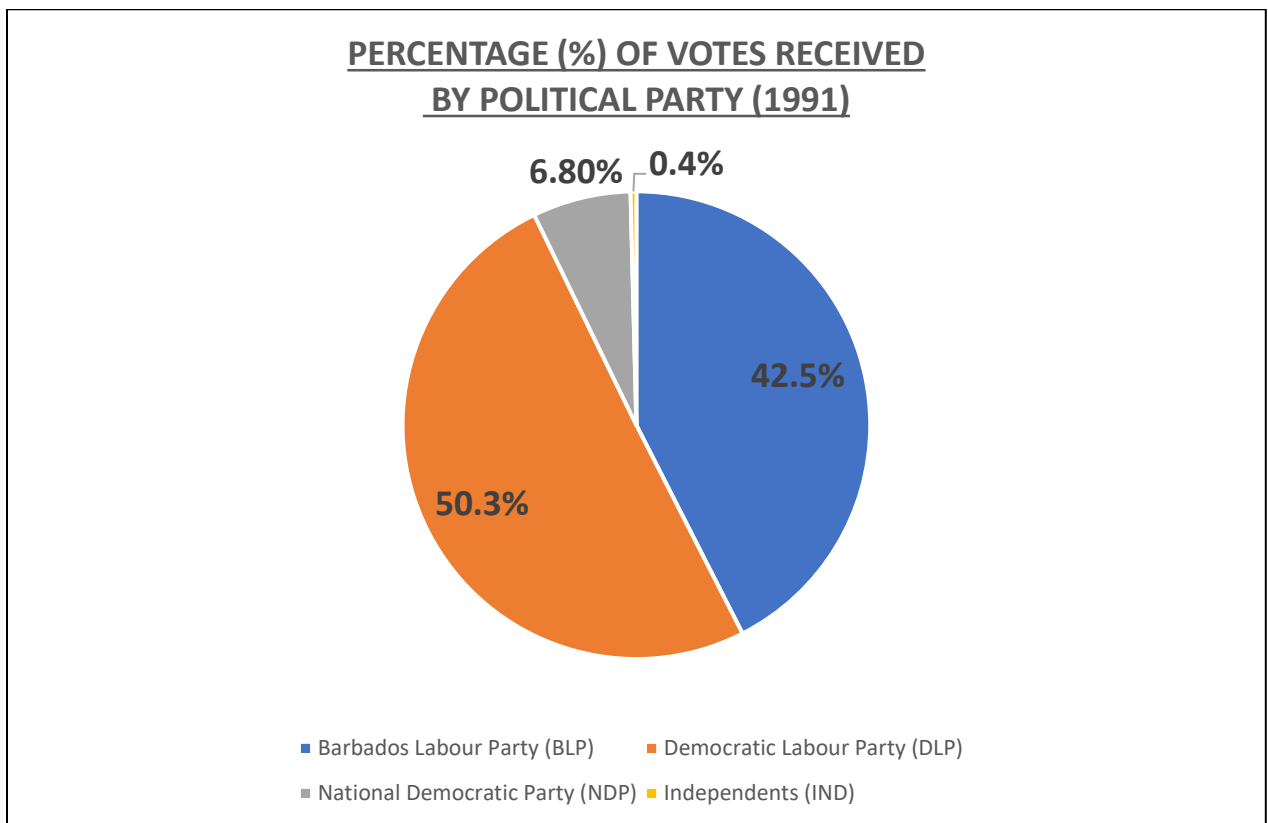


Figure 4: Percentage of voters received by political party (1991)
