



1994 Elections

On the 18th June, 1994 the Governor General issued a proclamation dissolving Parliament. Writs were also issued on 12th August, 1994 appointing Nomination Day as the 22nd August, 1994 and Election Day as Tuesday 6th September, 1994. The Supervisor of Elections was Mersada Elcock, the Deputy Supervisor of Elections was Hensley Robinson and Mr. Dennis A. Smith was appointed as Consultant.

One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine (1,969) Election Officers were deployed at the Polling Stations: -

There were 206,642 registered electors; 97,253 males and 109,389 females of which 60.9% or 125,822, voted - 57,648 males and 68,174 females. The BLP received 48.3%, DLP 38.3%, NDP 12.8% and IND 0.6% of the votes cast.




Figure 1: Number of registered voters by gender (1994)




Figure 2: Number of voters by gender (1994)




Figure 3: Percentage of electors voted by gender (1994)




Figure 4: Percentage of votes received by political party (1994)
