## **2003 Elections**

For the 2003 Elections, the number of constituencies was increased from 28 to 30.

The Writs for the Elections were issued on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2003 appointing Nomination Day as Tuesday 6th May 2003 and Election Day as Wednesday 21st May, 2003. On Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2003 the Governor General also appointed Thursday 15th May, 2003 as the Polling Day for Foreign Service Electors and Special Polling Day for Election Officers.

The Supervisor of the Elections was Hensley H. Robinson while the Deputy Supervisor of Elections was Donville Johnson.

Two thousand two hundred and six (2,206) Election Workers were deployed at the Polling Stations as follows:




Figure 1: Number of registered voters by gender (2003)




Figure 2: Number of voters by gender (2003)




Figure 3: Percentage of voters by gender (2003)




Figure 4: Percentage of votes received by political party (2003)
