Sir,

I have the honour to submit my Administrative Report on the third General Election of members to serve in the House of Assembly since the introduction of Adult Suffrage.

GENERAL

2. The direction and supervision of, and the procedure at the election was in accordance with the provisions of the Representation of the People Act, 1957. Notes for the guidance of election officers were prepared by the Supervisor of Elections and these notes were supplemented by lectures to and discussions with the election officers a number of whom were serving for the first time. The general assistance rendered by the Deputy Supervisor of Elections, Mr. L. H. Clarke, and other members of my staff is greatly appreciated.

3. The efficient manner in which the Returning Officers, Election Clerks, Poll Clerks and Counting Assistants performed their respective duties was largely responsible for the smooth functioning of the election machinery in each constituency and their able and loyal assistance is also sincerely appreciated.

4. I also wish to record my appreciation of the arrangements made by the Commissioner of Police for maintaining order at all Polling Stations. The police also supervised the important work of marking the 100 yards limit on the roads leading to all polling stations, within which limit the congregation of persons was forbidden by law, and the excellent discipline maintained at all polling stations was largely due to the strict enforcement of this regulation by the Police and the Special Constables.

Polling Stations

5. Buildings owned by Central Government (principally schools) or Local Government authorities were requisitioned, whenever practicable, for use as polling stations. In addition it was necessary to rent a number of privately owned buildings for which rentals of \$15, \$20, or \$30 were paid according to the size of the polling station required.

6. There were 110 polling stations distributed as follows:-

7. In 81 polling districts here the number of persons on the Register of Electors exceeded 800, polling stations were divided into two sections, each with its own Presiding Officer and Poll Clerks, and the Register divided about equally between each section. In 3 polling districts the number of persons on the Register of Electors exceeded 1,600 and it was necessary in these cases to divide the polling stations into three sections.

Election Officers

8. The following Election Officers were appointed:-

- (a) Supervisor of Elections and Deputy Supervisor of Elections appointed by the Governor;
- (b) 12-Returning Officers (one for each Constituency) and 14 Election Clerks (three for the Constituency of St. Michael and one for each of the other eleven Constituencies) appointed by the Governor-in-Executive Committee on the recommendation of the Supervisor of Elections;
- (c) 197 Presiding Officers, 409 Poll Clerks and 120 Counting Assistants distributed as follows:-

Presiding Officers were appointed by the Governor-in-Executive Committee, on the recommendation of the Supervisor of Elections; Poll Clerks and Counting Assistants were appointed by the Supervisor of Elections.

Equipment

9. All polling compartments and ballot boxes were provided by the Supervisor of Elections and the Returning Officers and Election Clerks for the several constituencies arranged for their distribution to the Polling Stations and for their collection after polling day. In all constituencies arrangements were made by the Supervisor of Elections for the safe storage of this equipment at convenient places in buildings owned either by Central Government or Local Government Authorities. The co-operation of all concerned in this matter is appreciated.

10. The present distribution of equipment is as follows:-

The Polling Booths and Ballot Boxes which are stored at Glendairy Prison were used in the Constituencies of Bridgetown, St. Michael, Christ Church and St. Philip.

11. Rubber stamps bearing the official words to be stamped on ballot papers and all printed forms, maps, stationery and incidentals necessary for the work of the Election Officers were supplied by the Supervisor of Elections.

PUBLICITY

12. Printed forms giving in detail the boundaries of the polling districts within each constituency and the location of the polling station for each district were posted by the respective Returning Officers at the buildings in which polling stations were established, as well as at Police Stations, Council Buildings, Libraries, Social Centres and such other places as were deemed necessary for the information of the electorate. In addition, all newspapers published notices directing attention to the above information.

13. Each polling station was provided with a map showing the district served by that station, as well as the boundaries of the adjacent districts with their respective polling stations so that any elector who presented himself at the wrong station might be directed to his correct station. It is remarkable, however, that in spite of the extensive publicity given to the preparation of the new Register of Electors earlier in the year and the appeals made to the electorate by means of the press, Rediffusion, posters and the cinemas to ensure that their names

were included in the Register, a number of which would be turned away from the polling stations because, as a result of their neglect in heeding these appeals, their names were not included in the Register of Electors.

14. Candidates and their agents were also supplied with copies of the forms indicating the location of each polling station within their respective constituencies and giving details of the boundaries of each polling district in order that they might further instruct the electorate in these matters during their political campaigns either by personal canvassing or by/use of circulars. The Supervisor of Elections also invited candidates and their agents to discuss with him at their convenience any points in regard to the procedure for the conduct of the election. It will be seen, therefore, that no efforts were spared to ensure that the fullest publicity possible was given to all phases of the electoral procedure as it affected the electorate, election officers, candidates and their agents. Nothing was left to chance.

STORAGE OF ELECTION DOCUMENTS

15. In accordance with the provisions of section 47(1) of the Representation of the People Act, 1957, twenty-one (21) sealed bags containing all election documents forwarded to the Supervisor of Elections by the Returning Officers for the respective constituencies were delivered to the Registrar on the 8th December, 1961, for storage.

CANDIDATES' ELECTION EXPENSES

16. Returns of election expenses were forwarded by all candidates to the Supervisor of Elections in accordance with the provisions of section 39 of the Representation of the People Act, 1957. These returns were transmitted to the Registrar within fourteen days of their receipt and a statement published in the local press as provided under section 46 of the above-mentioned Act.

17. The following is a summary of the candidates' election expenses:-
