Sir,

I have the honour to submit my report on the first General Election since the island became an independent country within the Commonwealth on the 30th November, 1966 and the first to be held under single member constituencies.

Dissolution of the House of Assembly  
and Date of Election

2. The House of Assembly was dissolved by His Excellency the Governor General on the 16th August, 1971; Notice of Election was the 18th August, 1971; Nomination Day was 25th August, 1971 and the General Election was held on the 9th September, 1971.

5. The Supervisor and Deputy Supervisor of Elections were appointed by the Governor General, the Returning Officers, Election Clerks and Presiding Officers by the Cabinet on the recommendation of the Supervisor of Elections; the Poll Clerks and Counting Assistants by the Supervisor of Elections.

#### Polling Stations (See Appendix 'A')

6. There were 212 polling stations throughout the island, of which 110 were buildings owned by Government and the remaining 102 privately-owned, for which rentals of \$30.00 or \$50.00 were paid according to the size of the station required. Polling Stations were opened at 6.00 a.m. and closed at 6.00 p.m. This proved satisfactory as a considerable number of electors were able to cast their votes before going to work, with the result that at some stations no elector turned up to vote after 5.30 p.m.

#### Identification Cards

7. In accordance with the provisions of the Representation of the People Act 1971, among other things an elector was asked to produce his identification card on applying for a ballot paper. In the event that he was unable to do so because the card had been lost or misplaced, reference was made by the Presiding Officer to the polling station card which contained the photograph of the applicant. There were a few instances of persons turning up at polling stations with identification cards but were unable to vote because their names were not on the register for that station. These persons had previously lived elsewhere and did not file a change of residence form with the appropriate Registering Officer on taking up residence in the new district. Their names however would still have been on the registers for the districts in which they previously lived.

Equipment

8. All equipment for use in the conduct of the election was provided by the Supervisor of Elections and the Returning Officers and Election Clerks for the several Constituencies arranged for their distribution to the polling stations and their collection after polling day.

9. The ballot boxes and polling booths are at present stored at the Prisons and the Chief Electoral Officer's office at "Verona" Bank Hall, St. Michael.

Publicity

10. Printed forms giving in detail the situation of each polling station and the description of the voters entitled to vote at the particular station, were posted by the respective Returning Officers at the buildings in which polling stations were established as well as at Police Stations and such other public places as considered necessary. In addition Government Notices appeared in the "Times" setting out similar information for the benefit of the electorate.

11. As a further means of assisting the electorate the Chief Electoral Officer sent out circulars to the 115,000 electors informing them of the constituency in which they reside and the location of their respective polling station within the Constituency.

12. It should also be noted that two (2) Government Programmes on C.B.C. T.V. were devoted to the procedure which electors should have followed on polling day, when attending the polls.

Storage of Election Documents

13. The election documents were delivered to the Supervisor of Elections by the Returning Officers for the respective Constituencies on the 10th September, 1971. The documents were kept under police supervision at "Verona", Bank Hall until the 17th September, 1971, when a total of thirty four (34) bags were delivered to the Registrar in accordance with Rule 56(2) of the Election Rules.

Candidates' Election Expenses

14. Returns of election expenses were forwarded by forty nine (49) of the candidates in accordance with the provisions of Section 52 (1) of the Representation of the People Act 1971. These returns have all been delivered to the Registrar in accordance with Section 60(1) of the above mentioned Act.

General

18. The Elections were conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Representation of the People Act, 1971. Several meetings were held with the Returning Officers and Election Clerks to discuss procedures and to make absolutely certain that the laws relating to the conduct of election were understood by all. Each Returning Officer held meetings with the Presiding Officers, Poll Clerks and Counting Assistants appointed to serve under him. In addition a booklet 'Notes for the Guidance of Election Officers' was prepared by the Supervisor of Elections for distribution to all election officers. I consider that the election officers performed their duties extremely well taking into consideration that the system was new and some were serving for the first time at an election.
