


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REPORT ON THE GENERAL ELECTION 1991

Introduction

On Saturday December 29, 1990, the Governor General, acting in accordance with the provisions of Section 61 (2) of the Constitution of Barbados issued a proclamation dissolving Parliament. Writs for an election were also issued that day to the twenty-eight Returning Officers appointed under section 31 of the Representation of the People Act Cap. 12.

2. The Writs appointed Nomination Day as Monday January 7, 1991, Polling Day Tuesday January 22, 1991, and Thursday January 24, 1991, as the latest date for the return of Writs to the Governor General.

Constituencies

- 3. In accordance with the provisions of Section 41D of the Constitution, the Electoral and Boundaries Commission reviewed the number and boundaries of the constituencies into which Barbados was divided as set out in section 3 (1) of the Representation of the People Act Cap. 12 and submitted its report to the Minister on December 6, 1989.
- 4. The report concluded that there should be an increase in the number of constituencies from the existing twenty-seven to twenty-eight. The report also recommended re-alignment of most constituencies consequent upon the enactment of the Parish Boundaries Act 1989-23.
- 5. The motion for the approval of a draft order by the Governor General to give effect to the proposals contained in the report was rejected by the House of Assembly on January 30, 1990. In accordance with the provisions of section 41D (4) the Minister amended the draft order. The amended draft was laid before the House of Assembly and the Senate and was approved by the House of Assembly on March 6, 1990, and by the Senate on March 7, 1990.
- 6. The Governor General acting in accordance with the provisions of section 41D (5) of the Constitution made the Electoral and Boundaries (Review of Boundaries) Order 1990 and which order came into force on December 29, 1990, following the dissolution of Parliament. The names and boundaries of the twenty-eight constituencies are set out as Annex I.

Candidates

7. Following the close of nominations on January 7, 1991, ninety-one candidates had been validly nominated to contest the election. The Barbado's Labour Party, the Democratic Labour Party and the National Democratic Party contested all twenty-eight seats. There were seven independent candidates.

Political Broadcasts

- 8. Provision is made under Regulation 4 of the General Elections (Allocation of Broadcasting Time) Regulations 1990, for the allocation of broadcasting time during an election period to any political party which satisfies the Commission that no less than ten of its members are validly nominated candidates for the election.
- 9. The three political parties which were represented in Parliament prior to the dissolution were all notified of this provision. The Democratic Labour Party and the National Democratic Party submitted the appropriate applications by Nomination Day January 7, 1991, for the allocation of broadcasting time. The Commission allocated broadcasting time as follows:

Democratic Labour Party

- (a) Sunday January 13, 1991
- (b) Thursday January 17, 1991
- (c) Sunday January 20, 1991

National Democratic Party

- (a) Tuesday January 15, 1991
- (b) Saturday January 19, 1991
- 10. The Barbados Labour Party responded on January 13, 1991, and was allocated Friday January 18, 1991, as its date for broadcasting time.

Election Officers

11. In addition to the Supervisor of Elections and the Deputy Supervisor of Elections, one thousand, seven hundred and nine officers were engaged in the conduct of the election. Allocations within the five categories of officers were as follows:

- 12. Training Sessions were held at the Electoral Office National Insurance Building, the Frank Collymore Hall and at various locations within each of the twenty-eight constituencies. Each election officer was given a copy of the Manual of Instructions for the office for which he was appointed.
- 13. A list of the names and addresses of the Returning Officers appointed under section 31 of the Act is at Annex II.

Registration of Electors

- 14. In 1988 the Commission conducted a house to house survey of voters in all twenty-seven constituencies. The first official list published following the survey was in January of 1989 and consisted of one hundred and seventy-five thousand, seven hundred and eight electors.
- 15. The registered electors in several of the constituencies did not conform to the formula set out in the third schedule to the constitution. The Commission, under the circumstances, reviewed the number and boundaries of the constituencies and submitted its report to the Minister.
- 16. In accordance with the provisions of section 18 of the Act, the Commission published the preliminary list of electors on Wednesday January 2, 1991. This list comprised one hundred and eighty-nine thousand, nine hundred and fifty-nine electors and was made available to the three political parties, as well as for public inspection at the Revising Centres. Notices were placed in the press inviting the public to inspect the list, and -
 - (a) file claims with the Registering Officers not later than Tuesday January 8, 1991, and
 - (b) file objections also with the Registering Officers not later than Thursday January 10, 1991.
- 17. Following the processing of the claims and objections, the register for elections was published on January 17, 1991, and comprised one hundred and ninety-one thousand electors.

Voter Information

18. In July 1990, the Commission published in the press, a list of approximately twelve thousand persons who, following the enumeration of 1988 were recorded as "deceased" or "not known" or "left address" or "left the island". Persons were asked to examine the list and report any discrepancy to the Chief Electoral Officer.

- 19. With the realignment of constituency boundaries and the creation of the additional constituency of Christ Church South, the Government Information Service prepared a series of programmes which were aired on Television as well as Radio outlining the changes. The newspapers also contributed significantly in providing the public with information on boundary changes.
- 20. Approximately eight to ten days before the election, a personal letter was sent to each elector providing such details as the name of the constituency in which the voter was registered as well as the location of his polling station. This service once again proved very informative since quite a number of persons were unsure of the boundaries of their respective constituencies following the electoral boundary changes and the alteration to the parish boundaries.
- 21. The public was also reminded of all actions which were likely to constitute election offences under the Election Offences and Controversies Act Cap. 3.

Polling Stations

- 22. Four hundred and sixty-seven polling stations were established for this election and were housed in two hundred and forty-eight buildings. Preference was given to the use of government owned buildings but it was necessary to rent buildings the rental charges varied from \$225 to \$350. A list setting out the locations of the two hundred and forty-eight buildings is attached as Annex III.
- 23. One new feature at this election was the introduction of the new polling booth. The booth is made of compressed card and is designed to be placed on a table, thus allowing the voter to sit and cast his vote. In addition it can be folded which permits easy handling. So convenient is the new booth that all the booths for an election in a constituency can be transported in the boot of a motor car in a single journey.

Counting of Votes and Publication of Results

- 24. At previous elections there were serious complaints about the long time Presiding Officers were required to wait at polling stations for transportation of the ballot boxes to the counting centre. In an attempt to avoid repetition or such complaints, buses from the Transport Board were used to provide the transportation from the polling stations to the counting centres. This new arrangement although beset with minor problems proved not only to be more efficient but resulted in a significant reduction in transport costs.
- 25. The counting of the votes took place at a central location within each constituency. The count was scheduled to commence at 8.00 p.m., but did not commence until 8.30 p.m., in two constituencies as a consequence upon the late arrival of ballot boxes from the polling stations.

- 26. Returning Officers as usual gave progress reports of the count in their respective constituencies at intervals during the night.
- 27. There was general satisfaction by all the Returning Officers that the count went smoothly and the candidates and their agents gave them full co-operation.

Return of Election Expenses

- 28. In accordance with the provisions of section 52 (1) of the Representation of the People Act all candidates/election agents are required to file a statement of election expenses with the Supervisor of Elections within seven weeks of the declaration of the results of the election.
- 29. The law permits candidates/election agents to incur expenses up to a maximum of \$1.00 in respect of each person registered as a voter within the constituency. A list showing the amount authorized and the amount expended by or on behalf of the candidates at the election is attached as Annex IV.
- 30. The case of Mr. Halton Martin a candidate for the constituency of St. Andrew who is alleged to have spent more than the allocation is currently receiving the attention of the Commission.

Statistical Data

31. The accompanying tables present in some detail the election results showing -

Table I - By constituencies the number and percentage of votes cast for each party.

Table II - By constituencies, the names of the candidates, the party each candidate represented and the number of votes cast for each candidate. (The name of the candidate elected in each constituency is placed first and printed in large type).

Table III - By constituencies, the number of registered voters and the number attending the polls.

Table IV - By each constituency the number of registered voters, the number who voted together with the percentage as well as the number of rejected ballot papers.
