

REPORT ON THE GENERAL ELECTION 1981

Introduction

On Tuesday 1981-05-26, the Governor General acting in accordance with the provisions of section 61 of the Constitution dissolved parliament and issued Writs to the Returning Officers for the twenty seven (27) Constituencies set out in the first schedule of the Representation of the People (Amendment) Act 1980-71. The notice of dissolution was published in the Official Gazette of 1981-05-26.

2. The Writs appointed Wednesday 1981-06-03 as Nomination Day and Thursday 1981-06-18 as Polling Day. The notices of election issued in accordance with Rule 3 of the House of Assembly Rules, were published in the Official Gazette of 1981-05-26 and in the press on 1981-05-27. The election was the first to be held since the membership of the House of Assembly was increased from 24 to 27 following the adoption of the report of the Select Committee of the House of Assembly on Boundaries and Designation of Constituencies.

Candidates

3. Sixty (60) candidates were nominated to contest the election. The Barbados Labour Party and the Democratic Labour Party each nominated twenty seven (27), while there were six (6) independents.

Preparation of Lists

4. In accordance with the provisions of section 18(1)(b) of the Act the revised register of electors was published on 1981-05-27, and comprised 164,676 names. This register was up for scrutiny until 1981-06-09, and persons invited to file claims or objections. It was subsequently updated in accordance with section 18(3) of the Act and published on 1981-06-15 as the Register for Elections.

5. Following the election, some candidates and their supporters, in commenting on the outcome of the election stated that a number of electors were disenfranchised and there were also allegations of the poll being rigged. The Prime Minister, minister responsible for electoral affairs directed the Chief Electoral Officer to carry out an investigation into events on polling day.

6. The Chief Electoral Officer in his report on the investigation stated at paragraph 34 and I quote:-

"34. The investigation has revealed that the allegations of -

- (a) mass removal of names from the register;
- (b) large numbers of electors being deprived of their constitutional right; and

(c) manipulation of the electoral process;

are without foundation. There were some discrepancies in the electoral list, but I am satisfied that such errors were of a genuine nature and there was no attempt by anyone or authority to interfere with the electoral process. No evidence has been produced to indicate that the elections were otherwise than free and fair. It is my view therefore, that there has not been an erosion of the democratic principles of free and fair elections in this country."

Polling Stations

7. Two hundred and fifty three (253) buildings were selected as polling stations within the twenty seven (27) Constituencies. Wherever possible preference was given to Government owned buildings, however it was necessary to rent in one hundred and nineteen (119) privately owned properties and rents ranged from \$100 to \$150, in accordance with the facilities provided. A complete list setting out the locations of these stations is set out in Appendix 'A'.

Election Officers

8. In addition to the Supervisor of Elections and Deputy Supervisor of Elections, one thousand, five hundred and sixty three (1,563) officers were engaged in the conduct of the elections. The distribution of these positions in the various offices within the twenty seven (27) Constituencies was as follows:-

9. Several training sessions were held with the Returning Officers and Election Clerks, in as much as some of these officers were serving in such capacities for the first time. These officers had the responsibility of training the Presiding Officers, Poll Clerks and Counting Assistants within their respective areas as it was impossible for the Supervisor of Elections and Deputy Supervisor of Elections to meet with such numbers. Appendix 'B' sets out the names and addresses of the Returning Officers.

Polling Compartments and Ballot Boxes

10. All polling compartments and ballot boxes were stored at Her Majesty's Prisons. Extensive repairs had to be carried out on the equipment as a result of damage by termites. Expenditure has been rising by over 100% at every occasion the repairs are needed and therefore it is appropriate that consideration be given to the use of metal boxes and booths at future elections in the interest of the economy.

11. The arrangements made for the transportation of booths were not carried out as planned in the first instance. Election officers reported that in a few cases all sections of the booths were not delivered at the stations, while some stations had more than the requirement. However the situation was remedied well before the commencement of the poll.

Storage of Election Equipment

12. The bags containing the election documents have been stored at the Registrar's Office in accordance with the provisions of Rule 56(2) of the Election Rules.

Candidates Election Expenses

13. Fifty four (54) of the candidates who contested the election filed returns and declarations with the Supervisor of Elections within the statutory period. In accordance with the provisions of Section 60(1) of the Act, the Returns and Declarations have been deposited with the Registrar.

14. The six (6) candidates/agents who failed to comply with the provisions of Section 52(1) are -

15. Applications were made to the High Court seeking relief in accordance with the provisions of Section 57 of the Act on behalf of -

- (a) Mr. Burton Hinds and his election agent
Mr. H. Walcott;
- (b) Mr. Lionel Craig and his election agent
Mr. A. Adams;
- (c) Mr. Ezra Alleyne and his election agent
Mr. A. Shepherd and
- (d) Mr. Arlington Edwards.

16. The Court granted relief to all of the applicants except Mr. Ezra Alleyne, whose application was refused. Mr. Alleyne has appealed against the decision.

17. Legal action is being taken against Mr. Rice and Mr. Wiggins.

18. A summary of Expenses as filed by the candidates is attached as Appendix 'C'.

Statistics

19. The accompanying tables present in some detail the election results:-

Table I Shows by Constituencies the number and percentage of votes cast for each party.

Table II Shows by Parties the number returned as members for the House of Assembly in the twenty seven (27) Constituencies.

Table III Shows by Constituencies the names of the candidates, the party each candidate represented and the number of votes cast for each candidate. The name of the candidate elected in each Constituency is placed first and is printed in large type.

Table IV Shows by Constituencies the number of registered voters and the number who attended the polls.

Table V Shows by each Constituency the number of registered voters, the number who voted together with the percentage and the number of rejected ballot papers.
