REPORT ON THE GENERAL ELECTION 1986

Introduction

The Governor-General acting in accordance with the provisions of Section 61(2) of the Barbados Constitution, issued a proclamation on Tuesday 6th May, 1986, dissolving Parliament. Writs for election were also issued on Tuesday 6th May, 1986, to the twenty-seven (27) Returning Officers appointed under Section 31 of the Representation of the People Act Cap. 12.

2. The Writs issued in accordance with the provisions of Section 36 of the Act appointed the following dates:-

Tuesday 13th May, 1986 - Nomination Day
Wednesday 28th May, 1986 - Polling Day
Friday 30th May, 1986 - Latest date for returns to Governor-General.

3. This General Election was the first to be conducted by the Electoral and Boundaries Commission which was appointed from the 1st April, 1985, following the proclamation of the Barbados Constitution (Amendment) Act 1981-24.

The Candidates

4. Sixty-one (61) candidates contested the twenty-seven (27) seats. Participation was as follows:-

27	-	Democratic Labour Party
1	-	Workers Party of Barbados

Election Officers

5. In addition to the Supervisor of Elections and the Deputy Supervisor of Elections, one thousand, six hundred and ninety-five (1 695) officers were engaged in the conduct of the Elections. The following shows the distribution of these officers in the five (5) categories within the twenty-seven (27) Constituencies:-

6. Notes for the guidance of election officers were prepared by the Supervisor of Elections and these notes were supplemented by lectures and general discussions.

7. A list of the Returning Officers appointed under Section 31 of the Act is at Appendix "A".

Register for Elections

8. In July 1985, the Electoral and Boundaries Commission took a decision to institute a house-to-house survey of voters with a view to up-dating the Voters List. There were numerous problems encountered. Enumerators in some instances did not perform their duties as expected of them, while in others, the response from the public was not at all times encouraging.

9. Following the conclusion of the survey, the Commission sent personal letters to those voters who were reported as not seen by the enumerators. Many persons responded to these letters and the Annual Register published on 31st January, 1986, showed a total of one hundred and sixty-six thousand, four hundred and forty-eight (166 448) persons entitled to vote compared with the one hundred and ninety-two thousand, four hundred and nineteen (192 419) at June 1985.

10. There was an explanation for this reduction since the last electoral survey was conducted in 1969 and there has not been any adequate machinery to monitor migration.

11. In a further effort the Commission continued to publicize its programme, culminating with the publication in the press, the names of these persons who were not seen by the enumerators or responded to the circular letters issued.

12. In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 of the Act, the Preliminary Lists were published on the 7th May, 1986, and comprised one hundred and seventy-three thousand, nine hundred and twenty-one (173 921) electors. These lists were made available for public inspection at the Revising Centres as well as at several other locations. Notices were also published inviting members of the public to:-

- (a) file claims for inclusion in the list by 13th May, 1986; and
- (b) file objections not later than 15th May, 1986.

13. The Registers for Elections were published on the 21st May, 1986, and comprised one hundred and seventy-six thousand, seven hundred and thirty-nine (176 739) electors.

Polling Compartments and Ballot Boxes

14. As a result of the high recurring cost of repairs to Polling Compartments and Ballot Boxes, the Commission on the advice of the Supervisor of Elections, decided to acquire metal Ballot Boxes in place of the wooden type. The Contract was awarded to Acme Manufacturing Company Limited to supply five hundred (500) of these boxes.

15. Unfortunately the Commission was unable to replace the wooden booths for this election but a decision has been taken to replace them with a metal type well before the next elections.

16. There has been a general satisfaction with the new Ballot Box since it is much lighter and more convenient to convey.

Polling Stations

17. Two hundred and forty-seven (247) buildings were selected as Polling Stations within the twenty-seven (27) Constituencies. Preference was given to the selection of Government owned buildings, however it was necessary to rent one hundred and twelve (112) privately owned properties. Rents for these properties ranged from one hundred and twenty dollars (\$120) to three hundred dollars (\$300) in accordance with the facilities provided. A complete list setting out the locations of these stations is set out as Appendix "B".

Public Relations

18. As at previous elections, printed forms giving detailed information on the boundaries of the polling divisions within each Constituency and the location of the Polling Stations were posted by the Returning Officers in their respective Constituencies. In addition the press also contributed in carrying this information to the general public.

19. The Government Information Service arranged for spot announcements to be carried by the radio and television stations, emphasizing the requirements to vote at an election.

20. As a further public service, the Supervisor of Elections sent each registered elector a personal letter giving details of the elector's registration number, polling division as well as the location at which the elector was entitled to vote. This service was very effective in that it minimized the problems election officials, candidates and their election agents usually encounter on Polling Day, especially when electors changed addresses and failed to notify the Electoral Office.

Storage of Election Documents

21. The election documents were stored at the following locations on the morning of 29th May, 1986:-
(i) Central Police Station
(ii) Oistins Police Station
(iii) Holetown Police Station,
before being finally sealed by the Returning Officers.

22. The sealed bags were handed over to the Registrar on the 5th June, 1986, in accordance with the provisions of Rule 56 (2) of the Election Rules.

Candidates' Election Expenses

23. Fifty-nine (59) of the candidates who contested the election filed Returns of Expenses in accordance with the provisions of Section 52 (1) of the Act. These returns have been deposited with the Registrar in accordance with Section 60 (1) of the Act. A summary of the expenses is at Appendix "C".

24. The Return of Expenses for Mr. Evans Webster one of the two delinquent candidates, reached the Supervisor of Elections on the 21st July, 1986, but was dated the 17th July, 1986, the final date for making the returns.

25. No communication has been received from Mr. Lisle Carmichael the other candidate, who apparently is now resident abroad.

Statistics

26. The accompanying tables present in some detail the election results:-

Table I - Shows by Constituencies the number and percentage of votes cast for each party.

Table II - Shows by Constituencies, the names of the Candidates, the Party each Candidate represented and the number of votes cast for each Candidate. The name of the Candidate elected in each Constituency is placed first and printed in large type.

Table III - Shows by Constituencies the number of registered voters and the number who attended the polls.

Table IV - Shows by each Constituency the number of registered voters, the number who voted together with the percentage and the number of rejected ballot papers.

General

27. A report reaching this office indicated that one Presiding Officer issued the first ten (10) voters attending the station with Tendered Ballot Papers. In another case, the Presiding Officer failed to lock the Ballot Box properly, resulting in the Election Clerk having to affix adhesive tape to secure it.

28. In evaluating its performance in the conduct of its first General Election, the Commission has arrived at the following conclusions:-

- (i) the method of selection of election officers will have to be reviewed.
- (ii) significant changes will have to be made in the arrangements for the transportation of Ballot Boxes to the Counting Centres.
- (iii) the need for greater dialogue with supporting agencies with special reference to cost of services.

29. The Commission wishes to express sincere thanks to all who assisted in the conduct of the election. Special mention must be made to the staff of the Data Processing Unit, the Government Printery and the Electoral Office.

30. The general public must also be complimented for understanding and discipline which contributed to the successful conduct of the election.

General

25. A report regarding this office indicating one
presiding officer issued the first few (10) voter affidavits
together with Tally Labels. In another case,
the Presiding Officer failed to lock the ballot box properly.
Resolving in the Election Clerk failed to file appropriate
records in the ballot box to secure it.

26. In analysing the performance in the conduct of the
first General Election, the Commission has arrived at the
following conclusions:-

(i) The majority of election officers
will fail to be renew.

(ii) Slighting of expenses will fail to be made in
the arrangement for the distribution of

ballot boxes to the Counting Centres.

(iii) The need for greater discipline with supporting
services with special reference to cost of
service.
