## REPORT ON THE GENERAL ELECTION 1994

### 1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 On 18 June 1994 the Governor General acting in accordance with the provisions of Section 61 (2) of the Constitution of Barbados, issued a proclamation dissolving Parliament. At the same time some indication was given of the proposed dates for the nomination of candidates and the conduct of the poll.
- 1.2 Writs were issued on 12 August 1994 appointing Nomination Day as Monday 22 August 1994, Polling Day as Tuesday 6 September, 1994 and Thursday 8 September 1994 as the latest date for the return of the writs to the Governor General.
- 1.3 The writs for the election were issued to the twenty-eight Returning Officers who were appointed under Section 31 of the Representation of the People Act Cap. 12.

### 2. ELECTION ADMINISTRATION

- 2.1 The Election was conducted by the Electoral and Boundaries Commission in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution and the Representation of the People Act Cap 12. The members of the Commission are:-

- 2.2 The Supervisor of Elections was Mrs Mersada A. Elcock while Mr. Hensley H. Robinson was appointed as Deputy Supervisor of Elections.
- 2.3 The Commission appointed Mr. Dennis A. Smith as Consultant to advise on all matters relating to the conduct of the election. The appointment took effect from 1 July to 30 September, 1994.

3. CANDIDATES

- 3.1 Ninety-five candidates were validly nominated on 22 August 1994 to contest the election. Representation of political parties was as follows:-

Barbados Labour Party	-	28 candidates
Democratic Labour Party	-	28 candidates
National Democratic Party	-	25 candidates

- 3.2 Fourteen Independent candidates were nominated.

4. POLITICAL BROADCASTS

- 4.1 Regulation 4 of the General Elections (Allocation of Broadcasting Time) Regulations 1990 provides for the allocation of broadcasting time during an election period to any political party which satisfies the Commission that no less than ten of its members are validly nominated candidates for the election.

- 4.2 The two political parties which were represented in Parliament prior to the dissolution of Parliament were notified of the provision. A third political party which was represented in parliament prior to the 1991 General Election and which, after the 1994 dissolution had indicated its proposed participation in the current electoral process, was notified also.

- 4.3 Appropriate applications were submitted by the political parties on the dates indicated below:-

Barbados Labour Party	-	23 August 1994
Democratic Labour Party	-	18 August 1994
National Democratic Party	-	23 August 1994

- 4.4 An application dated 25 August 1994 was made by the Rescue Mission of Independent Candidates for the allocation of broadcasting time. The group was required to satisfy the Commission that it met the legal requirements.

- 4.5 The Commission allocated broadcasting time as follows:-

Barbados Labour Party

- i) Wednesday 31 August 1994
- ii) Thursday 1 September 1994

Democratic Labour Party

- i) Sunday 28 August 1994
- ii) Friday 2 September 1994
- iii) Sunday 4 September 1994

National Democratic Party

- i) Saturday 3 September 1994

Rescue Mission of Independent Candidates

- i) Tuesday 30 August 1994

**5. ELECTION OFFICERS**

5.1 In addition to the Supervisor of Elections and the Deputy Supervisor of Elections, one thousand, nine hundred and sixty-nine election officers were engaged in the conduct of the election. Allocations within the five categories of officers were as follows:-

5.2 On Polling Day, in addition to those involved in the actual voting process, extra Poll Clerks were deployed at buildings which housed four or more stations and at four Information Centres.

5.3 Great emphasis was placed on the training of election officers. Training sessions were conducted for all categories of officers at various locations within each of the twenty-eight constituencies.

5.4 Returning Officers held meetings with candidates, election agents and polling agents.

5.5 Lists of the names and addresses of Returning Officers appointed under Section 31 and Election Clerks appointed under Section 32 of the Act are at Annex I and Annex II respectively.

**6. REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS**

- 6.1 Twenty-eight Registration Centres were opened six evenings each week from Monday to Saturday during the period 25 July to 12 August 1994 to provide increased access to registration services to voters during the period preceding the issue of the writs.
- 6.2 The additional period outside of the special registration period was used by voters to ensure that their registration records were accurate. At the same time the activities within the communities by the political party machinery and prospective candidates, assisted in the process of updating the voters list.
- 6.3 In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 of the Representation of the People Act the Commission published the Preliminary List of Electors on Saturday 13 August 1994. The list comprised 205, 822 electors and was made available to the three political parties and prospective independent candidates.
- 6.4 For the first time the Commission made the list available on floppy disks to political parties and candidates. This format proved useful to the parties, which through their field activities, provided useful information, thereby assisting the Electoral Department in updating the voters list.
- 6.5 The Preliminary List was made available for public inspection at the Revising Centres. Notices were placed in the Press, inviting the public to inspect the List and:-
- i) file claims with the Registering Officers not later than Friday 19 August 1994; and
  - ii) file objections with the Registering Officers not later than Monday 22 August 1994.
- 6.6 The Commission established four Registration Centres to provide access to the general public for the inspection of the Preliminary List as well as registration services.
- 6.7 Following the processing of claims and objections, the Register for Elections was published on 31 August 1994 and comprised 206, 642 electors.

7. VOTER INFORMATION

- 7.1 The medium of radio was used to inform the general public about the various stages of the electoral process. Emphasis was placed on encouraging voters to make maximum use of the special registration period to ensure that their names were entered on the register of electors.
- 7.2 Each elector was issued with a letter on 25 August 1994 which provided personal voter information extracted from the final register for elections.
- 7.3 On Polling day extra Poll Clerks assisted at buildings which housed multiple polling stations. They directed voters either to their stations on the compound or to Voter Information Centres.
- 7.4 Information Centres were established at the Sheraton Shopping Centre, Queens Park, the Alexandra School and the Electoral Department. These Centres were staffed by extra Poll Clerks who provided voter information.
- 7.5 Meetings were held with media personnel to clarify their roles on polling day and during the election night coverage.

8. POLLING STATIONS

- 8.1 Five hundred and forty polling stations were established for the election and were housed in two hundred and fifty-one buildings, the majority of which were government owned. It was necessary to rent some privately owned buildings at rates ranging from \$350 to \$450.
- 8.2 A list setting out the locations of the polling stations is attached at Annex III.
- 8.3 Three new polling divisions were created on a temporary basis and corresponding polling stations established in the constituencies of St Michael North East, St Philip North and St. Thomas. The divisions were done on a geographical basis and were precipitated by the need to provide electors in those districts with easy access to places of voting. The following polling districts were divided:-

**9. COUNTING OF VOTES AND  
PUBLICATION OF RESULTS**

- 9.1 After the close of the poll buses from the Transport Board were used to provide transportation from polling stations to the Counting Centres. Once again this system proved efficient and only in a few cases ballot boxes arrived late at the counting centres.
- 9.2 In most constituencies the count commenced at 8.00 p.m.
- 9.3 During the count the Returning Officers made periodic progress reports.
- 9.4 In the constituency of St. Michael Central, a recount was requested by Mr. Christopher Sinckler, the Democratic Labour Party candidate. The first count was in favour of Mr. Ishmael Roett, the Barbados Labour Party candidate by fifteen votes. The recount took place at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday 7 September 1994 at the Combermere School after which Mr. Ishmael Roett was declared the winner by twenty votes.
- 9.5 Generally there was satisfaction by Returning Officers that the count was conducted smoothly with the full cooperation of the candidates and their agents.
- 9.6 The number of rejected votes declined significantly in relation to the 1991 election. The reduction may be attributed to the printing of ballot papers in varying sizes based on the number of candidates contesting the election in the respective constituencies.

**10. RETURN OF ELECTION EXPENSES**

- 10.1 In accordance with the provisions of Section 52 (1) of the Representation of the People Act, all candidates/election agents are required to file a statement of election expenses with the Supervisor of Elections within seven weeks of the declaration of the results of the election.
- 10.2 The law permits candidates/election agents to incur expenses up to a maximum of \$1.00 in respect of each perso registered as a voter within the constituency. A list showing the amount authorised and the amount expended by or on behalf of the candidates at the election is attached at Annex IV.
- 10.3 The Commission is reviewing the following cases:
- i) Ms Demora Kirton, candidate for St. Michael Central, did not submit a declaration - Form 6 as required by Section 53 (1);
  - ii) in respect of three candidates, Mr Clyde A Mascoll - St James South; Mr Larry St.G Walcott - Christ Church East Central; and Mr Peter A. Barrow - St. Michael Central, returns were made to the Supervisor of Elections after the statutory period prescribed by Section 52 (1);
  - iii) Mr Gordon Matthews, candidate for St Michael West Central submitted expenses totalling \$ 11, 789.84, an amount which exceeds the limit prescribed by Section 48.

**11. ISSUES**

- 11.1 During the period of election the level of public interest was at its highest and many related topics were raised in the public forum. The Commission noted the matters of public concern and identified important issues to be addressed in the near future. The issues include the following:-
- i) the great number of applications by voters for transfers as a result of changes in record and the disproportionate size of the register of electors to total population, indicate the necessity to conduct voter enumeration programme in advance of the conduct of an election;

- ii) the arrangements for voting by election officials who man polling stations need to be reconsidered;
- iii) the secrecy of the ballot was questioned because of the statutory requirement to record the electoral number of the voter on the counterfoil of the ballot paper;
- iv) whether a candidate's affiliation to a political party should be stated on the ballot paper;
- v) the application for broadcasting time by a group of independent candidates raises the question relating to the registration of political parties;
- vi) reports of the establishment of candidate's or political party's campaign headquarters within the 100 yards limit of polling stations, need to be examined;
- vii) the limit allowed for a candidate's election expenses need to be raised;
- viii) whether there ought to be any restriction on the publication of results of public opinion polls during an election period.
